Pursuant to sections 5107.05, 5160.43 and 3125.25 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

The following Ohio Administration Code rules are being proposed for amendment as a result of a review conducted in accordance with section 106.03 of the Revised Code (ORC), which requires five-year reviews of all state agency rules.

- Rule 5101:12-01-56, "Assigned Medical Support Collection Incentives," This rule describes the distribution of assigned medical support collections. Changes to the rule include revising the language in paragraph (C)(2) that the remainder is distributed to Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM).
- Rule 5101:12-10-31, "Requirement to Cooperate with the Child Support Enforcement Agency," This rule describes the requirement for an applicant for or a recipient of Ohio works first (OWF), medicaid, or Title IV-E foster care maintenance (FCM) benefits to cooperate with the child support enforcement agency (CSEA) in establishing paternity or in establishing, modifying, or enforcing a support order. Changes to the rule include adding language to paragraph (D)(1)(b)(i) for clarification that cooperation is not required unless the caretaker is in the same assistance group as the child.
