Pursuant to Chapter 119. and section 5164.02 of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) gives notice of ODM's intent to consider the amendment of the rule identified below and to hold a public hearing on this rule.

Rule 5160-1-60, "Medicaid payment," is being amended. In Appendix DD to this rule, the maximum payment amount for the submission of the electronic Pregnancy Risk Assessment form (PRAf) is increased and a maximum payment amount is established for submission of a new Report of Pregnancy (ROP) form. Both forms are addressed in rule 5160-21-04, "Pregnancy related services," which is being amended separately.

In addition, Appendix DD to rule 5160-1-60 is being amended to reflect new 2021 payment amounts for electroencephalogram (EEG) procedures represented by CPT codes in the range 95717–95726 that were formerly "carrier priced" under Medicare.

Pursuant to Am. Sub. H. B. 404 (133rd G. A.), which amends Section 12 of Am. Sub. H. B. 197 (133rd G. A.), ODM will hold the public hearing for this rule via teleconference. The date, time, phone number, and PIN (access code) this hearing are listed at the top of this Notice. All interested parties are invited to participate in the public hearing. Both oral and written testimony will be accepted for this hearing and will be given the same consideration. Persons who want to give oral testimony are asked to send a message by electronic mail (e-mail) to rules@medicaid.ohio.gov no later than one hour before the hearing to be added to the witness list. There will be a final call at the end of the hearing for persons who wish to offer oral testimony but do not yet appear on the witness list.

Written comments submitted by e-mail, postal mail, or fax that are received or postmarked no later than the day of the hearing will be accepted as testimony and will become part of the hearing record. All testimony will become public record; therefore, ODM asks that protected health information (PHI) be excluded unless the information belongs to the person submitting the testimony or to a person for whom the submitter is a legal guardian. Written testimony sent by e-mail is highly recommended. All persons who submit testimony by e-mail will be sent a confirmation of receipt.
