• OAC 3301-35-15 Standards for the implementation of positive behavior intervention supports and the use of restraint and seclusion. Operating Standards for K-12th grade (Rescind/New)

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3301-35-15 are the Standards for the implementation of positive behavior intervention supports and the use of restraint and seclusion. The rule provides requirements for schools to implement positive behavioral interventions and supports and parameters regarding the use of restraint and seclusion. The rule is being amended to provide for additional definitions; to provide for professional development requirements for the implementation of positive behavior intervention and supports; to account for students with multiple incidents of restraint and/or seclusion; and to provide a restraint and seclusion complaint process for parents who believe a school district has violated certain provisions of the rule.

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Ohio Revised Code Section 3301.53(C) requires the State Board of Education, in consultation with the Director of Job and Family Services, to adopt rules for school child programs that are consistent with and meet or exceed the requirements of the rules adopted for child day-care centers that serve school-age children under Chapter 5104. of the Revised Code. The rules are being amended for clarity and to better align definitions and terms in the rules to definitions of the terms in Revised Code. OAC 3301-32-06.1 is proposed to be in compliance with ORC 3301.52-59 which includes the requirement to meet or exceed child care rules put into place by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.

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These rules address the program operating standards for Child Day-Care Programs, which are applicable to preschool programs operated by school district boards of education, county boards of developmental disabilities, community schools, or eligible nonpublic schools. The rules are being amended for clarity and to better align definitions to the definitions of terms in the Revised Code. OAC 3301-37-03.1 is being proposed to be in compliance with ORC 3301.52-59 which includes the requirement to meet or exceed child care rules put into place by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.
