ODRC will conduct a public hearing to obtain comments concerning ODRC's proposed revisions to the following Administrative Rule as required by Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code:

- **5120-15-01 Certification of qualification for employment**  
Relative to a petition for a Certificate of qualification for employment, the proposed changes exclude information contained in any record sealed under R.C. 2953.32 from the summary of the individual's criminal history. (H.B. 110, 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly).
- **5120:1-1-41 Standards for imposing, modifying and reducing post-release control**  
The proposed changes clarify that post-release control is imposed consistent with a court's journal entry and is modified, reduced, or terminated in accordance with R.C. 2967.28; removes outdated references to post-release control periods consistent with changes made by H.B. 110 (134<sup>th</sup> GA); updates language regarding the overriding purposes of felony sentencing consistent with R.C. 2929.11. Additional changes are made consistent with H.B. 110: clarifies when post-release control may be reduced or terminated; removes a provision that allowed the duration of post-release control to be increased by up to eight years; removes juvenile court adjudications finding the offender to be a delinquent child from the information the parole board uses in imposing post-release control.
