



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Board of Building Standards will convene for a public hearing in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, at 10:00 A.M., Friday, April 26, 2024 in Hearing Room #1, at 6606 Tussing Road, Reynoldsburg, Ohio, 43068. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit testimony on proposed actions taken on select rules of the Administrative Code, identified as Amendments Group CII (102) pursuant to Chapters 119., 3781., 3791., 4104., and 4105. of the Revised Code.

Synopsis of the proposed rule changes:

PART A – OHIO BOILER and PRESSURE VESSEL RULES

The Board proposes to amend the Ohio Administrative Code as follows: **Chapters 4101:4-1 to 4101:4-10 (15 rules)**. The rule amendments are proposed to comply with the five-year rule review, to remove regulatory restrictions, and to update the various ASME, NBBI, and NFPA referenced standards relating to the design, construction, installation, repair, alteration, maintenance and operation of boilers and pressure vessels.

PART B – OHIO ELEVATOR RULES

The Board proposes to amend the Ohio Administrative Code as follows: Chapters **4101:5-1 to 4101:5-3 (9 rules)**. The rule amendments are proposed to comply with the five-year rule review, to remove regulatory restrictions, and to update the ASME referenced standards relating the design, construction, repair, alteration, and maintenance of elevators.

The full text of the proposed rules were filed electronically with the Legislative Service Commission (LSC), the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR), and the Secretary of State as required in section 119.03 of the Revised Code. Prior to electronic filing of the rules, a stakeholder meeting was held for the boiler and elevator rules and electronic notification was provided to all stakeholders. The proposed rules and a Business Impact Analysis were posted and submitted to the Common Sense Initiative (CSI) Office. Additionally, the Clerks of the 88 County Commissioners were notified of the filings as required by statute.
