LEGAL NOTICE STATE OF OHIO OHIO DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAID

Pursuant to section 1902(a)(13)(A) of the Social Security Act and 42 CFR 447.205, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (department) gives notice of the department's intent to modify provisions relating to positive incentive payments to, and negative incentive payments collected from, Principal Accountable Providers (PAPs) participating in the Medicaid program.

The Episode Based Payment (EBP) model was established to create an Ohio specific valuebased purchasing model to reward high-quality care and outcomes. The Episodes program establishes PAPs for a defined episode of care (EOC) and encourages clinical effectiveness, supports referral to providers who deliver high-quality care, and applies financial incentives to evaluate the cost and quality of care delivered for each episode. PAPs receive a positive incentive payment if their average cost for a certain episode falls below a predetermined threshold and they meet specific quality measures. PAPs whose cost is above a predetermined threshold are held responsible by being assessed a negative incentive. Due to COVID-19 and the changes in patient behavior related to seeking medical care, ODM intends to suspend assessing providers' performance and payments under the EBP model for calendar years 2020 and 2021. The change will result in no PAPs being assessed either a positive or negative incentive payment for calendar years 2020 and 2021.

Implementation of this change in the methods and standards for setting payment rates is expected to have no impact on annual aggregate expenditures for any of the following state plan benefit categories or services:

- Chiropractors' Services
- Physician Assistants' Services
- Advanced Practice Nurses Services
