LEGAL NOTICE STATE OF OHIO OHIO DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAID

Pursuant to sections 1902(a)(13)(A) of the Social Security Act and 42 CFR 447.205, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (Department) gives notice of the Department's intent to adopt a new methodology to provide Ohio hospitals with additional payments due to the significant and continuing challenges resulting from the public health emergency. These payments are to ensure continued adequate access for Medicaid recipients to inpatient and outpatient services, and the long-term sustainability of hospitals.

The additional payments will be calculated either based on a per-discharge or per-visit amount across all hospitals, or on a per-discharge or per-visit amount across all hospitals in a peer group, as determined by the Department. The Department estimates the average inpatient per-discharge add-on to be \$1,724.00 and the average outpatient per-visit add-on to be \$86.00, which are subject to change based on the final implementation policy.

These additional payments will be distributed to hospitals through one or more of the following methodologies as determined by the Department:

- Per-discharge or per-visit amount added to hospital rates
- Per-discharge or per-visit amount Directed Payments by Managed Care Plans
- Directed Payments by Managed Care Plans
- Directed payments on a quarterly basis not part of standard Managed Care Plan rates

The Department estimates that this will increase annual aggregate Medicaid expenditures for inpatient and outpatient hospital services by \$1.4 billion.
