

**FEDERAL MEDICAID NOTICE**  
**OHIO DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAID**

The director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (department) gives notice of the department's intent to renew Ohio's Specialized Recovery Services Program under section 1915(i) of the Social Security Act, including the associated waiver for the Recovery Management service under section 1915(b)(4) of the Social Security Act.

Amendments in this renewal include updates to the quality improvement strategy to reflect more applicable performance measures, and the state's plan for improved monitoring and oversight. No substantive changes have been made to methodologies or processes identified in the (b)(4) waiver.

No changes have been made to methods or standards for setting payment rates for the Specialized Recovery Services Program or Recovery Management service; therefore, these changes are expected to have no impact on annual aggregate expenditures.
