

**LEGAL NOTICE
STATE OF OHIO
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAID**

Pursuant to section 1902(a)(13)(A) of the Social Security Act, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (department) gives final notice of the department's modification of provisions relating to the reimbursement of intermediate care facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IIDs) participating in the Medicaid program.

An initial notice was issued in June 2021 to inform the public of proposed changes in reimbursement to ICF/IIDs for Medicaid services. This final notice reflects the result of the public and legislative processes.

Due to changes recently enacted by the State legislature, effective July 1 2021, ICF/IIDs will be reimbursed for services rendered to Medicaid recipients in state fiscal year 2022 (FY22) as follows:

- **For existing ICF/IIDs** - ICF/IID rates for all ICF/IIDs participating in the Medicaid program on June 30, 2021 will increase by 2% over the Medicaid per diem rate in effect for the ICF/IID on June 30, 2021; and
- **For new and incoming ICF/IIDs** - New and incoming ICF/IID providers participating in the Medicaid program on or after July 1, 2021, shall receive a rate of \$357.89 in FY22, which is a 2% increase over last fiscal year's statewide average rate of \$350.87.
