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PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services (OhioMHAS) will hold a public hearing for the purpose of accepting testimony on the proposed changes to the following rule:

O.A.C. 5122:1-3-01 – Financial requirements for boards

OhioMHAS is not proposing any changes to this rule, which establishes application, eligibility, allocation methods, accounting standards, auditing standards, and financial reporting requirements for the disbursement of funds to alcohol, drug addiction, and mental health services (ADAMHS) boards. However, a hearing is required because OhioMHAS made a correction in the digits of the authorizing statute, which should be R.C. 5119.22 instead of R.C. 5199.22. (In other words, there was typographical error in the authorizing statute.)

At this hearing, OhioMHAS will accept verbal and written testimony on the rule. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code. Any person affected by the rules may appear and be heard in person, by his or her attorney, or both; may present his or her position, arguments, or contentions, orally or in writing; offer and examine witnesses; and present evidence tending to show that the rules, if adopted or effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
