## Public Notice Public Hearing and Proposed Rulemaking Governing Section 401 Water Quality Certifications

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Sections 6111.03, 6111.30, and 6111.31 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 119, proposes to original file and hold a public hearing for the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code:

These rules address Section 401 Water Quality Certifications regulations. The purposes of this rule making are to complete the five year reviews of three rules as required by Ohio Law and to create new rule 32-04 to comply with the requirements of House Bill 175.

The public comment period will run until Thursday May 9, 2024. A public hearing on this proposed rulemaking will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. Ohio EPA will be holding an in-person and virtual public hearing on the rules on Thursday May 9, 2024 at 2:15 p.m. The inperson hearing will be at the same time and date and will be located at State Library of Ohio, 274 E. First Ave., Columbus, OH 43201. During the hearing, the public may submit written comments on the record about the proposed rules if participating virtually and verbally if participating in person.

Registration for the in-person hearing is not required. Citizens intending to give testimony at the hearing should notify the Ohio EPA Public Interest Center, P.O. Prior registration will ensure that registrants are heard ahead of those individuals who register at the hearing. Oral testimony may be limited to five minutes, depending on the number of persons testifying. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and to present oral and/or written comments concerning the proposed rule making.

Written comments submitted after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit.
