Notice of Public Rules Hearing

May 30, 2024 at 1:30pm

In accordance with Chapter 119 of the Revised Code (R.C.), the Director of the Ohio Department of Health announces a Public Hearing at the date and time listed above to hear comments regarding the following action:

Swimming Pools

3701-31-03, -04

This rule package establishes the regulations surrounding public swimming pools and spas establishes swimming pool license fee categories and establishes the responsibilities of the licensor of public swimming pools or spas including requirements surrounding verification of plan approval by ODH, inspection requirements, licensing requirements, fee calculations, and the requirement to collect and transfer licensure fees, amended to require licensors to forward incident data that it receives from its licensees to ODH by the end of each month it is received, establishes the responsibilities of the licensee including licensing requirements, operational requirements, water quality requirements, requirements surrounding the disinfection of pools, and safety requirements, contains two appendices which outline fecal incident response recommendations for pool staff from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and design requirements for diving areas in pools, amended to add to the injury reporting requirements by requiring licensees to report any incidents that results in death, serious injury, assistance from emergency medical personnel, or an illness involving more than one person to the licensor within seventy-two hours of the incident.

Hearing and Contact Information:

Information about the hearing, people affected by the proposed action may appear via teleconference and be heard or in tandem with an attorney. They may present their positions, arguments, or contentions orally or in writing; may offer witnesses; and may present evidence showing that the proposed rule, if adopted or effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
