Pursuant to section 3125.25 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

The following OAC rules are being proposed for amendment as a result of a review conducted in accordance with section 106.03 of the Revised Code (ORC), which requires five-year reviews of all state agency rules.

- Rule 5101:12-1-80, "IV-D contracts: overview," describes the process by which a child support enforcement agency (CSEA) enters into a IV-D contract with a governmental entity or a private entity to provide IV-D services; the rule lists the types of IV-D contracts and the procurement process, terms and definitions and the required contracts forms. The rule has been amended to remove restrictive language throughout the rule.
- Rule 5101:12-1-80.1, "Completing the IV-D contract," describes the process for completing a IV-D contract and it outlines the terms that must be agreed upon by the parties to the IV-D contract being completed by the CSEA, the contractor, or another entity. The rule has been amended to remove restrictive language throughout the rule; and added new language in paragraph (B)(6)(b) regarding example of performance standards for IV-D contracts.
- Rule 5101:12-1-80.2, "IV-D contract submission requirements and acceptance," describes the IV-D contract submission and acceptance process. The rule has been amended to remove restrictive language throughout the rule.
- Rule 5101:12-1-80.3, "IV-D contract time and exception reporting, invoicing, monitoring, and evaluation," identifies the requirements of IV-D contract time and exception reporting, invoicing, monitoring, and evaluation. The rule has been amended to remove restrictive language throughout the rule.
- Rule 5101:12-1-80.4, "IV-D contract record retention," identifies what is a IV-D record and outlines how long the CSEA and IV-D contractor will retain such records. The rule has been amended to remove restrictive language throughout the rule.
