

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Department of Commerce in accordance with Ohio Revised Code § 119.03 intends to amend two rules governing Prevailing Wage Regulations found in Ohio Administrative Code § 4101:9-2-02.1 and 4101:9-2-02.2.

The following rules are being amended for the reasons set forth below:

4101:9-2-02.1 and 4101:9-2-02.2:

This rule package allows for an employer to hire minors ages 16-17 to engage in certain occupations in the construction trade that were previously prohibited, with certain conditions.

The Department will conduct a public hearing on the proposed rules on September 17, 2024, at 1:15 p.m. at the offices of the Division of Industrial Compliance, 6606 Tussing Road, Training Room 3, Reynoldsburg, Ohio 43068-9009.

At the public hearing, any person affected by the proposed actions may appear and be heard in person, by the person's attorney, or both, may present the person's position, arguments, or contentions, orally or in writing, offer and examine witnesses, and present evidence tending to show that the proposed rule or amendments, if adopted or effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.

Any person who wishes to present his or her position, arguments or contentions in writing may do so by mailing his or her written comments to the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Industrial Compliance, Office of Division Counsel, 6606 Tussing Road, Reynoldsburg, OH 43068. Written comments may also be submitted at the hearing. All written comments must be submitted to the Department no later than 5:00 p.m. September 17, 2024. Written comments submitted after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit.
