Pursuant to section 5153.166 and 5103.03 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the adoption, amendment, or rescission of the rule or rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

OAC rule 5101:2-33-14 entitled "PCSA requirements for recording a child fatality or near fatality" is being proposed for amendment. This rule provides the process of recording child fatality or near fatality for PCSAs. This rule was amended to remove regulatory restrictive words as described in Senate Bill 9 of the 134<sup>th</sup> General Assembly. Changed all system references to Ohio's Comprehensive Child Welfare Information System (CCWIS) to align with the federally recognized case management information system to support child welfare program needs. Ohio's CCWIS consists of several automated systems approved by the Children's Bureau including the Ohio Statewide Automated Child Welfare Information System (SACWIS) and Taking Early Action Matters (TEAM) Ohio.
