Pursuant to sections 5107.05, 5107.76 and Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the adoption, amendment, or rescission of the rule or rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:1-23-70, entitled Ohio Works First: Erroneous Payments, is being proposed for amendment as a result of a five year review. This rule describes erroneous payments for the Ohio works first program. OFA amended this rule to remove regulatory restrictive words as part of Senate Bill 9; Paragraph (G) has been stricken; Moved paragraph (G)(2) and (G)(3) to paragraph (H)(4)(a)(b) for clarity and minor language changes were made to improve clarity.

Rule 5101:1-23-70.1, entitled Ohio Works First: Ohio Works First: Overpayments of Aid to Dependent Children/Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Cash Assistance and/or Ohio Works First that Occurred Prior to July 1, 1998, is being proposed for amendment as a result of a five year review. OFA amended this rule to remove regulatory restrictive words as part of Senate Bill 9 and minor language changes were made for clarity.

Rule 5101:1-23-70.2, entitled Ohio Works First: Work Allowance Overpayments that Occurred Prior to October 1, 1997, is being proposed for amendment as a result of a five year review. OFA amended this rule to remove regulatory restrictive words as part of Senate Bill 9 and minor language changes were made for clarity.
