Pursuant to sections 5153.166, 5103.03 and 5101.141 and Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the adoption, amendment, or rescission of the rule or rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

Rule 5101:2-42-19.1, entitled <u>"Requirements for independent living arrangements for independent living youth in custody"</u>, is being proposed for amendment for a five-year rule review and to add clarification on how custodial agencies can support an independent living arrangement. This rule sets forth how agencies can utilize an independent living arrangement as a placement setting for youth in their custody. The changes to the rule include removal of restricted language and updated language to clarify agency's option to utilize independent living funds for supportive services provided at an independent living arrangement. Language was added to strength an agency's requirement to determine appropriateness of an independent living arrangement for youth in custody.
