The public hearing will be conducted on **Monday**, **December 2**, 2024 beginning at 9:00 am, and continue until all parties in attendance have had an opportunity to be heard.

The following rules are proposed for amendment to clarify and establish requirements:

4501:1-7-02 Conditions for issuance of license plates, removable windshield placards and temporary

removable windshield placards for persons with disabilities.

4501:1-7-15 Materials incorporated reference

The following rule is proposed for rescission:

4501-3-01 Public notice of proposed rule adoption, amendment or rescission.

Persons affected by the proposed rules may appear at the hearing and be heard in person, or by an attorney, or both, or may present their position, argument, or contention in writing. Persons may offer and examine witnesses and present evidence to show that the proposed rules will be unreasonable or unlawful if enacted.
