NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held by the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”) on **May 12, 2025, at 10:00 a.m.** at its main office, located at 100 E. Broad Street, 20th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public comment on the rule contained in ERF package number 212610, the summaries of which are below.

Rule Summary

3772-5-03 – titled “Key employee license” (amendment) This rule currently sets the key employee license application fee at \$2,000 and the license fee at \$500. The rule further clarifies under what circumstances entities engaged in casino gaming may pay the fee on behalf of the employee. The purpose of this rule is to set fees commensurate with the investigation and licensure costs that the Commission incurs during the licensing investigation, consistent and in accordance with R.C. 3772.03, 3772.15, and 3772.17. The amendment to the rule reduces the application fee to \$1,750, which mirrors a cap set forth in an amendment to R.C. 3772.13, effective April 8, 2025.

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
