OAC Chapter 3301-13 Proficiency Tests (1 rule)

OAC 3301-13-02 Administering state tests at the designated grades. (Amend)

This rule establishes the criteria for who can serve as administrators for state tests. Recent legislative changes to Ohio Revised Code section 3319.22 require updates to this rule to ensure that school psychologists can continue to serve as administrators for state tests.
