LEGAL NOTICE STATE OF OHIO OHIO DEPARTMENT OF MEDICAID

Pursuant to section 1902(a)(13)(A) of the Social Security Act, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (department) gives final notice of the department's modification of provisions relating to the reimbursement of nursing facilities participating in the Medicaid program.

An initial notice was issued in May 2022 to inform the public of proposed changes in reimbursement to nursing facilities for Medicaid services. This final notice reflects the result of the public and legislative processes.

The department added a temporary nursing facility benefit to the Medicaid Program in 2020 to cover isolation or quarantine services for individuals who could not safely receive those services where they resided. Nursing facilities could apply to participate as specialty providers and those facilities jointly approved by the Department of Health and the Department of Medicaid could provide quarantine and/or isolation services under the Health Care Isolation Center (HCIC) benefit. On April 7, 2022, CMS issued a notice to state survey agencies that rescinded certain flexibilities considered in the joint agency approval of HCIC providers. As a result, Medicaid ceased to accept billing for HCIC services provided on or after June 7, 2022, and providers will resume billing using usual and customary nursing facility service billing codes.
