Pursuant to 42 CFR 447.205, the director of the Ohio Department of Medicaid (department) gives notice of the department's intent to change its methods and standards for Medicaid payment for eyeglass frames and lenses.

A new vendor contract has been awarded through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services (DAS) for the procurement of eyeglass frames and lenses. This new contract includes updated payment rates for eyeglass frames and lenses.

Implementation of this change in the methods and standards for setting payment rates is expected to increase annual aggregate expenditures for eyeglass frames and lenses by approximately \$173,000.
