4755-1-02 Method of public notice in adopting, amending or rescinding rules.

- (A) The occupational therapy section of the Ohio occupational therapy, physical therapy, and athletic trainers board shall comply with the provisions of section 119.03 of the Revised Code for the purposes of adoption, amendment, or recission of rules. Compliance shall include giving proper and reasonable public notice of rule changes. Prior to the adoption of any rule subject to the requirements of Chapter 119. of the Revised Code by the occupational therapy section of the Ohio occupational therapy, physical therapy, and athletic trainers board, public notice of the section's intention to consider adoption, amendment or reseission shall be given at least thirty days prior to the date set for the public hearing. Notice shall be given in the register of Ohio. The occupational therapy section may also issue any notice or publication to ensure that constructive notice is given to all persons who are subject to or affected by the proposed rule. The notice shall include:
  - (1) A statement of the occupational therapy section's intentions to consider adoption, amendment or reseission of a rule;
  - (2) A synopsis of the proposed rule, amendment, or reseission, or a general statement of the subject matter to which the proposed rule, amendment or reseission relates; and,
  - (3) A statement of reason or purpose of adoption, amendment or reseission of rules; and,
  - (4) The date, time and place set for the public hearing on the proposed action.
- (B) The occupational therapy section of the Ohio occupational therapy, physical therapy, and athletic trainers board shall comply with the provisions of section 106.03 of the Revised Code when reviewing existing rules.
- (C) Pursuant to section 119.0311 of the Revised Code, the Ohio occupational therapy, physical therapy, and athletic trainers board shall publish a guide to public participation in rule-making.
- (D) Any person may receive notice of a proposed rule, amendment, or rescission by visiting the board website or by contacting the board to receive notice via e-mail or mail.
- (B) Any person may receive notice by supplying the occupational therapy section with stamped, pre-addressed envelopes.
