NOTIFICATION OF PUBLIC HEARING
Notice of hearing to amend
Rules 4501:2-10-05 & 4501:2-10-09
of the Ohio Administrative Code in accordance with
Chapter 119. of the Ohio Revised Code

Notice is hereby given that a hearing will be held by the Ohio Highway Patrol Division of the Ohio Department of Public Safety for the purpose of considering proposed amendment of the above-listed administrative rules.

As authorized in Section 5503.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Ohio Highway Patrol Division of the Ohio Department of Public Safety proposes to amend Rules 4501:2-10-05 & 4501:2-10-09 of the Ohio Administrative Code regarding the Law Enforcement Automated Data System known as "LEADS." Proposed changes are for the purpose of updating the requirements for validation records to better reflect technological changes, to add a date for a cited federal regulation, and to add conditions that will allow access to the system by public children services agencies for the emergency placement of children in exigent circumstances.

A public hearing on the proposed rules will be held Wednesday, March 10, 2004 at 2:00 PM in room 109 (first floor) of the Charles D. Shipley Building, Ohio Department of Public Safety, 1970 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.

Either written or oral testimony will be received at the hearing. Additionally, written comments received at the address below before the hearing will be treated as testimony.
