Pursuant to sections 5101.141, 5103.03, 5103.15, 5153.16 and 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the director of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services gives notice of the department's intent to consider the amendment of the rules as identified below and of a public hearing thereon.

OAC 5101:2-42-06 entitled Agreement for temporary custody of child sets forth the requirements of a temporary custody agreement between the public children service agency (PCSA) and the private child placing agency (PCPA) and a parent. This rule has been amended to update the statutory authority and rule amplification statutes.

OAC 5101:2-42-07 entitled Extension of agreement for temporary custody of child sets forth the requirements of a temporary custody agreement between the PCSAs and PCPAs and a parent upon the request of an extension. This rule has been amended to update the statutory authority and rule amplification statutes.

OAC 5101:2-42-19.1 entitled Requirements for independent living arrangements for independent living youth in custody sets forth the requirements for the PCSAs and PCPAs when placing a youth in its custody in an independent living arrangement. This rule has been amended to clarify the age requirements pertaining to independent living arrangements.
