The Department is rescinding rule 5123:2-17-03 (Abuser Registry) and adopting a replacement rule of the same title numbered 5123-17-03. The rule sets forth procedures to be used to determine whether the name of a person (i.e., a "DD Employee") should be placed on the Abuser Registry and standards for determining whether such person has been rehabilitated and may have his or her name removed from the Abuser Registry. The following are considered DD Employees:

- Employees of the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities;
- Employees of county boards of developmental disabilities;
- Persons who are employed in positions that include providing specialized services (i.e., services designed and operated to serve primarily persons with developmental disabilities) such as employees of Agency Providers certified by the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities;
- Independent Providers certified by the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities; and
- Employees of residential facilities licensed by the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities.

New rule 5123-17-03 contains, verbatim, the content of rule 5123:2-17-03. The only change being made at this time is to the rule number itself, which, in accordance with the Department's established course, is being changed to eliminate the division number. No changes are being made to the content of the rule.
