Amended Rules

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Sections 3710.02 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 119, proposes to amend the following rules of the Ohio Administrative Code:

3745-22-02	Prohibitions
3745-22-03	General application procedures and provisions for contractors, specialists, designers, air monitors, and workers
3745-22-04	Contractor application requirements, criteria, and standards of conduct
3745-22-05	Asbestos hazard abatement specialist application content, qualifications, standards of conduct
3745-22-06	Asbestos hazard evaluation specialist application content, qualifications, standards of conduct
3745-22-08	Asbestos hazard abatement worker application contents, qualifications, standards of conduct
3745-22-09	Asbestos hazard abatement project designer application content, qualifications, standards of conduct

These rules are part of the Ohio EPA Asbestos Licensing/Accreditation Program. The amendments will allow Ohio EPA to apply to U.S. EPA for approval of our asbestos licensing program and demonstrate how our program meets the requirements found in the "Asbestos Model Accreditation Plan" 40 CFR part 763, Appendix C to Subpart E.

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the Division formally adopts them. On Mach 17, 2020, these rules went out for a 30-day review by interested parties. No comments were received.

Ohio EPA will be holding a virtual public hearing on the proposed amended rules on **Friday, October 9, 2020** at **10:30 AM**. The meeting will be held exclusively online. During the virtual hearing the public can submit written comments that will be read into the record by the hearing host. Ohio EPA held a public hearing on Friday, October 9, 2020 regarding potential amendments to OAC Ch, 3745-22 Asbestos Licensing Rules. This document summarizes the comments and questions received at the public hearing, which ended on (insert date).

Ohio EPA reviewed and considered all comments received during the public comment period. By law, Ohio EPA has authority to consider specific issues related to protection of the environment and public health.

In an effort to help you review this document, the questions are grouped by topic and organized in a consistent format. The name of the commenter follows the comment in parentheses.

General/Overall Concerns

Comment 1:

We have a recurring question in asbestos training classes that requires clarification. When performing an asbestos activity greater than 3 square or linear feet but less than 50 SF/LF, does the new rule require the use of a licensed worker or supervisor? (Wayne Ingram, Training Services International, Inc.)

Response 1:

3745-22-01_(C) "Asbestos hazard abatement activity" means any activity involving the removal, renovation, enclosure, repair, or encapsulation or operation and maintenance of reasonably related friable asbestos-containing materials in an amount greater than fifty three linear feet or fifty three square feet. Asbestos hazard abatement activity also includes any such activity involving such asbestos-containing materials in an amount of fifty linear or fifty square feet or less if, when combined with any other reasonably related activity in terms of time and location of the activity, the total amount is in an amount greater than fifty linear or fifty square feet.

OAC 3745-22-02 (F) No person shall perform any asbestos hazard abatement activities unless he or she is certified as an asbestos hazard abatement worker or an asbestos hazard abatement specialist by the director in accordance with Chapter 3710. of the Revised Code and pursuant to the requirements of this chapter.

The proposed rule allows either a certified asbestos hazard abatement worker or a certified asbestos hazard abatement specialist to perform an abatement activity.
